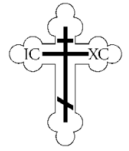

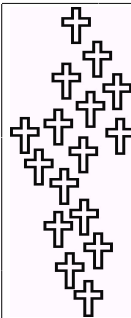

for the UNBORN

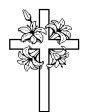

## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

**Baptized** parishioners between the ages of **16** (on or before May 31, 2011) **and not yet 18 who are still in high school** are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes run September to April/May of the following year most Sundays, 9:40-10:40AM.

**Candidates** are required: to provide proof of Baptism; to attend class; to participate in class service project, parish Life Teen, retreat, and a day of reflection with sponsors.

**Sponsors** are required: to provide a statement of eligibility & proof of reception of sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, & Holy Eucharist); participation in a day of reflection.

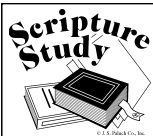

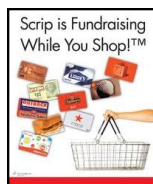

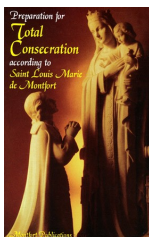
### **SAFeway RECEIPT CONTEST for QofA School Please keep saving RECEIPTS!!**
